The Embassy of Switzerland presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Federal Republic of Somalia and has the honour to inform the Ministry that the Swiss Government offers a limited number of scholarships to East African students for the academic year 2024-25.

These scholarships are only for Research Fellowships, PhD or Postdoctoral studies of one year duration (for PhD three years) at Swiss Universities with exception of studies in Fine Arts. The age limit is 35 years except for Postdoctoral studies. The Swiss Government does not offer scholarships for undergraduate and master studies to East African students.
